A Child's Day at the Early Childhood Laboratory School of Housatonic Community College

- Morning Welcoming Circle Children welcome each other to the classroom and discuss a language, math, science or social study concept.
- Free Learning Time Children interact with each other in the learning centers. The teacher conducts a focused learning experience involving language, art, science, math or social studies. Teachers use the CT Preschool Curriculum Framework Standards in planning learning experiences.
- Music Time Children participate in teacher-led music experiences
- Outdoor Exploration Children participate in experiences in the outdoor play area
- Story Time The teacher reads a book related to the learning theme.
- Lunch This is also a time for teachers and children to socialize and talk about life events.
- Rest Time and Quiet Reading

The afternoon consists of enrichment activities, including music or story time and outdoor play.
