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

Introduction

In this report you will find a ten-year trend of the characteristics and demographics of the graduates of Housatonic Community College. This past year (academic year 2017-18) five-hundred-eighty-five (n=585) degrees and/or certificates were awarded to five-hundred-thirty-four graduates (n=534). Fifty (n=50) students earned two degrees/certificates. *Please note that the academic year is defined as students who earned a degree(s) and/or certificate(s) in summer 2017, fall 2017, and/or spring 2018. * The number of degrees and certificates awarded showed a decrease of 5.6% (n=-35) from the previous 2016-17 academic year. The percentage of certificates and degrees awarded have remained stable over last year.

Degrees and Certificates Awarded 2017-18




Above is a graph showing the breakdown of certificates and degrees awarded in 2017-18.



The number of certificates that have been awarded in the past ten years have increased faster (n=89, 164.8%) than Associate degrees awarded (n=49, 12.4%).

Percentage of Degrees/Certificates Awarded by Gender (10 Years)




The number of degrees and certificates awarded to both males and females in 2017-18 represented an increase of 16.9% (n=48) in females and an increase of 44.7% (n=63) in males over the last ten-year period at HCC. The proportion of the female graduating classes have declined over the past ten years from 66.8% to 61.9% while the proportion of males in the graduating classes have increased from 33.2% to 38.1%.

Male and Female Graduates at Housatonic Community College



Age of Graduates (10 Years)




The mean age is not the best representation for reporting, but for the sake of consistency it is shown above.

The number of graduates who identify themselves as White have increased by 26% (n=40) over the last 10 years. The number of graduates who identify as Black have increased by 85% (n=68) over the last 10 years. The number of graduates who identify as Hispanic have increased by 79.1% (n=72) over the last 10 years. The Other graduates (consisting of graduates who identify as Asian, Native American, Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian, Pacific Islander and/or are Multi-Race) have decreased by 14.3% (n=-5) over the last 10 years. There was 1 graduate who chose to not respond or were missing a response this academic year (2017-18). Starting in 2009 efforts to obtain every student's race and ethnicity have been made in order to gain accurate information about students.


Percentage of Degrees and Certificates Awarded by Student Ethnicity/Race (10 Years)



Race/Ethnicity of Graduates at Housatonic Community College



The majority of graduates live in the Bridgeport area, which has increased by 29.7% (n=52) over the past 10 years. The number of Ansonia residents has increased by 50% (n=5) over the past 10 years. The number of Derby residents has decreased by 42.9% (n=3) over the past 10 years. The number of Easton residents has decreased by 50% (n=-1). The number of Fairfield residents has decreased by 12.5% (n=-3) over the past 10 years. The number of Milford residents has increased by 3.4% (n=1) over the past 10 years. The number of Monroe residents has increased by 14.3% (n=2) over the last 10 years. The number of Seymour residents has remained steady over the past 10 years. The number of Shelton residents has increased by 23.3% (n=7) over the past 10 years. The number of Stratford residents has increased by 18.8% (n=12) over the past 10 years. The number of Trumbull residents has increased by 65% (n=13) over the past 10 years. The number of residents from outside the HCC service area has increased by 43.5% (n=20) over the past 10 years.



Within the HCC service area, majority of graduates earned a high school diploma from Central Magnet High School. The number of students increased by 5.7% (n=3) over the past 10 years. The number of graduates who graduated from Bullard-Haven HS have increased by 44% (n=11) over the past 10 years. The number of graduates who graduated from F. Scott Bunnel HS have increased by 55% (n=11) over the past 10 years. The number of graduates who graduated from Warren Harding HS increased by 22.2%, (n=4) within the past 10 years.

Where the horizontal line ends on the right represents the highest GPA of the graduating class at (n=4.00).
