DONOFRIO PUBLIC MEDIA SCHOLAR AND INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

PROGRAM BACKGROUND

Through a partnership between Connecticut Public and the Connecticut State Colleges and Universities (CSCU) system and funded through the generosity of Nick and Anita Donofrio, this program will provide opportunities for students interested in careers in media and/or communications to receive a scholarship or educational stipend to support the cost of their degree program to attend a Connecticut community college. Scholarship or stipend awards may be used for tuition, fees, books, transportation, child care or equipment.

In addition, the program designates a CT Public internship for a student at a CSCU community college to supplement their academic experience with a paid internship to provide real-life-based experience in a public media organization. The internship assignment will be at Connecticut Public corporate offices in Hartford or at the Gateway Community College location in New Haven. There is a separate internship application process managed by Connecticut Public and available to students in the community college system. Donofrio Scholarship applicants and awardee(s) are encouraged to apply.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: Up to \$4,000 annually for one or more scholarships. EDUCATIONAL STIPEND: Up to \$2,000 annually for one or more stipends.

SCHOLARSHIP/STIPEND CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

- 8. Resident of Connecticut
- 9. Open to second year, full-time CSCU community college students who are studying in the fields of communications, journalism, broadcasting, television production, digital arts, digital media production, or marketing.
- 10. Part-time students are eligible if the scholarship increases the number of credits that can be taken allowing student to accelerate their associate degree program.
- 11. Student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA (A = 4.0)
- 12. Student must demonstrate financial need and state on the application how the scholarship or stipend would be used to cover the cost of education or education related expenses.
- 13. The college will confirm both the applicant's financial need through review of the FAFSA and their GPA through review of their transcript before final selection by the CSCU Foundation.

CONNECTICUT ART EDUCATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD: up to \$1,000

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Student must be a Connecticut resident
- 2. Scholarship is available to art majors in their sophomore, junior or senior years enrolled in art education programs at **Central Connecticut State University** or **Southern Connecticut State University**
- 3. Student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA (A = 4.0)
- 4. Student must demonstrate financial need
- 5. In addition to scholarship application, student must provide a resume that covers:
 - i. Any honors or scholarships received
 - ii. Any involvement in professional organizations
 - iii. Any involvement in NAEA/CAEA student chapter (if one exists in your school) how long, offices held, list of any conferences attended, list of presentations given at conferences
 - iv. Any accomplishments within the content area exhibition experience, publishing experience, other art or art education related involvement or experiences inside or outside of the Art/Art Education department

CELIA W. BROWN MEMORIAL GRANT FOR THE VISUAL ARTS

- 1. The Celia W. Brown Grant is awarded to a student studying abroad or out of state in the visual arts.
- 2. Each year \$500 is given to a student at one of the four universities.

- 3. Selection criteria to be established by the chair of the Art Department for each university or designee of the university president. Student must be in good academic standing. Preference should be given to a student studying for a semester or a full year.
- 4. The Art Department Chair shall inform the university president once a selection has been made and provide a written rationale for the chosen student.
- 5. The funds can be used by each university anytime during their designated year. If, however, by January 1, a university does not feel it will have a suitable candidate during their year, the Chair of the Art Department (or designee) should notify the CSCU President so that the stipend can be made available to the next campus in alphabetical order.
