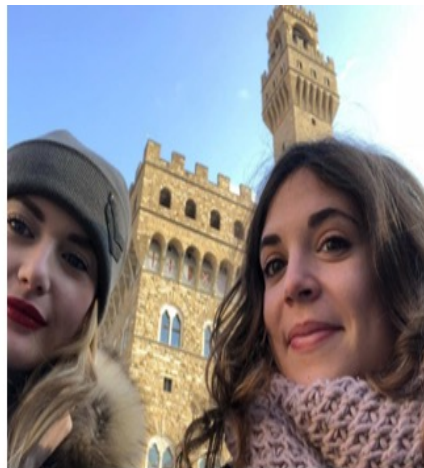

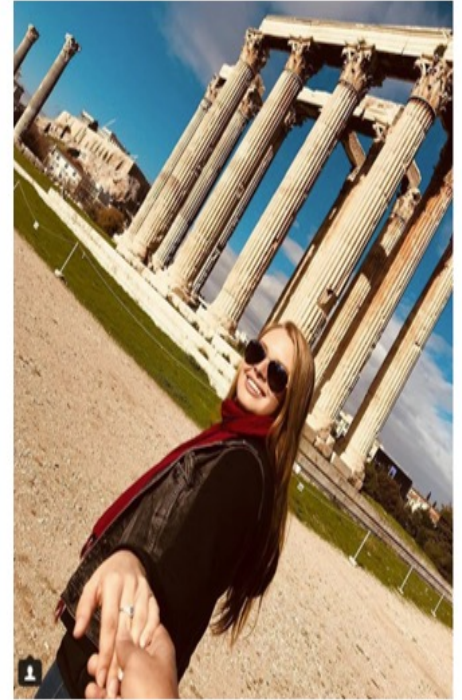

HUMANITIES 119: INTERCULTURAL STUDIES IN ITALY AND GREECE (SPRING 2023)

Through a series of in-class lectures, discussions, and site visits, this course explores the roots of Western Civilization and the impact of classical Greek and Roman culture on modern history, philosophy, the arts, cuisine and the present-day world. Students will have the opportunity to visit breathtaking ancient ruins, explore medieval neighborhoods untouched by time, and marvel at Renaissance masterpieces in world-renowned museums. Throughout the journey, students will connect with locals and get an insider's view of contemporary Mediterranean life in Italy and Greece

Weeks 1-6

- Weekly class meetings offering presentations, lectures, and discussions related to history, language, art, cultural norms and practices.

Weeks 7-8 (Travel weeks)

- Daily lectures, site visits and class discussions.

Weeks 9-10

- Design and create course blog; trip reflections

Weeks 11-15

- Weekly class meetings offering presentations, lectures, and discussions related to the performing arts, literature and music.

How much does this cost?

- \$3555 plus course tuition
- Scholarships are available.

What's included?

- Roundtrip airfare
- Hotel Accommodations
- Ground transportation between countries
- Transportation to all sites
- Travel Insurance
- Entrances to all sites including The Roman Forum, The Colosseum, the Sistine Chapel, the Temple of Apollo, the Ruins of Delphi, the Parthenon, and Olympic Stadium
- Daily lectures from local experts
- Daily breakfast and 3 dinners

How many credits do I earn?

- Students must enroll in the course to earn 3 Humanities credits that satisfy numerous requirements regardless of your program of study.

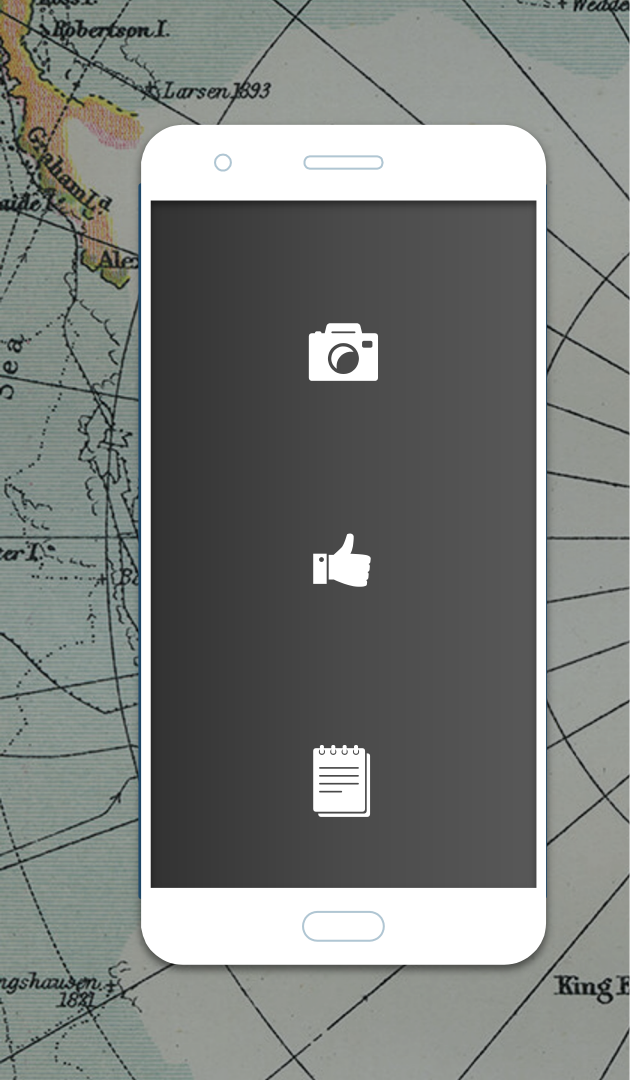
