## Geographic Distribution of Housatonic students

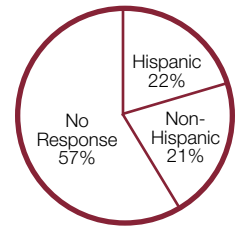

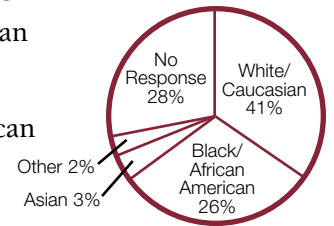


## Racial Distribution\*
