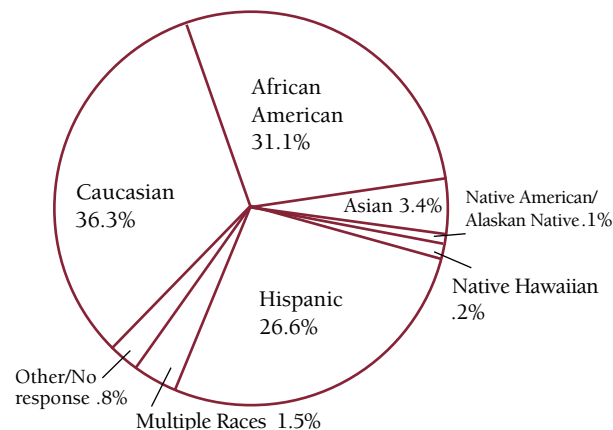
Geographic Distribution of Housatonic students
