## What is the Vehicle for Change (VFC)?

The Vehicle for Change is a program of **Opening Doors Fairfield County**. It provides outreach and services to youth and young adults, between the ages of 16-24, throughout Fairfield County. It is a community-driven approach that meets young people where they are, removing the traditional barriers that youth often face when they are trying to connect to supportive services.

If you or someone you know is struggling with housing instability, homelessness or in need of healthcare, mental health services, employment, basic needs, and/or other social services, please come speak to one of our team members on the van. Our team includes staff from several community organizations who are committed to working together so that young people in our communities have increased opportunities and the support necessary to thrive.
